COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Earth Science is the study of the Earth and its neighbors in space. It is an exciting science with many interesting and practical applications. The three basic areas of Earth Science we will study this year are: geology (the study of rocks, minerals and plate tectonics), meteorology (the study of weather and climate), oceanography (the study of Earth's oceans) and astronomy (the study of the universe). This is a lab-oriented course that follows the New York State Standards for Regents Earth Science. There will be an emphasis on observation, investigation and collecting and analyzing data within the labs. All eligible students will take the Physical Setting/Earth Science Regents Examination in June 2020.



SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- 2 3 inch binder with loose leaf paper
- Earth Science folder
- pens and pencils (only pencils for labs)

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS:

- Be <u>Prompt</u> be on time, lateness will not be tolerated (3 tardies = 1 absence)
- Be <u>Prepared</u> come to class with the required materials and assignments
- Be *Polite* respect yourself, each other, our differences, and all school property
- Be *Productive* come to class curious, enthusiastic and with a good attitude
- Be <u>Present</u> this means **NO CELL PHONES.** Cell phones should not be used at all during class time. If cell phone use becomes an issue in the classroom, students will be required to place their phones in designated pockets hanging on the wall by the door. Cell phone use in class will result in after school detention with me.

HOMEWORK & ATTENDANCE POLICY:

- Students can expect homework assignments regularly. Homework will always be given a specific due date and late homework assignments will not receive full credit. All homework assignments must be 100% complete to be accepted.
- If a student is absent from class, the student is responsible for obtaining the work they missed. Please ask a friend, check the classroom folder, or visit the course website/calendar to obtain missing homework assignments and information. Students will be given three days to complete work after an absence to receive full credit.
- You must be present for 85% of the school year. If you miss more than 15% of the school year (27 absences) you will not be eligible to take the NYS Regents Exam in June.

LAB POLICY:

• You must complete 1200 minutes of laboratory instruction. Earth Science is a lab-based course! Students may work together to use lab equipment, make observations, collect data, and form conclusions. However, the written report should reflect your OWN thinking, effort and language! Late labs will be accepted, but there will be a grade penalty for lateness. Students who do not complete 1200 minutes of laboratory instruction will not be eligible to sit for the NYS Regents Exam in June.

GRADING POLICY:

Your quarterly grade will be recorded in eSchool and determined by the follow system:

40% Tests & Projects

30% Labs

10% Quizzes

10% Homework

10% Classwork & Participation

BONUS POINTS:

Each quarter, you will have the opportunity to boost your quarterly average by 3 points!

1 point - all labs for the guarter are completed and submitted

1 point - all labs for the quarter have final passing grades

1 point - all weekly sheets for the quarter are completed and submitted

EXTRA HELP:

Students are expected and encouraged to come see me if you need help with class work, labs, homework, and/or studying. Extra help will be offered Monday through Thursday in Room 38 until 3:00PM. If you are not able to come for extra help but would like to meet with me, speak with me so we can schedule something else!g

If you are told to come to mandatory extra help, you are expected to stay after school in Room 38 from 2:15 until 3:00.
